# Minnesota Adventure Runner

18" x 60"



## MATERIALS:

[1] AMNSH panel

1/3 yard for inner block border

1/3 yard for outer block border

1/3 yard for runner border and backing

1 yard backing (If you don't want to piece it, get 1-2/3 yards)

3/8 yard, for binding

*READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. FOR THIS PATTERN, WE WILL CUT STRIPS BY THE WOF (WIDTH OF FABRIC)*

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### From AMNSH Panel:

Trim 4 pictures to 9-1/4" x 11-1/4"

### From Inner Block Border Fabric:

Cut [5] - 1-1/2" x WOF

Sub cut [8] - 9-1/4" x 1-1/2" rectangles

Sub cut [8] - 13-1/4" x 1-1/2" rectangles

### From Outer Block Border Fabric:

Cut [6] - 1-1/2" x WOF;

Sub cut [8] - 11-1/4" x 1-1/2" rectangles

Sub cut [8] - 15-1/4" x 1-1/2" rectangles

### From Runner Border Fabric:

Cut [4] - 2-1/2" x WOF

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY::

1. Stitch an inner block border 10-1/2" rectangle to each side of each picture.
2. Stitch an inner block border 12-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of each step 1 unit.
3. Stitch an outer block border 12-1/2" rectangle to each side of the step 2 units.
4. Stitch an outer block border 14-1/2" rectangle to each side of the step 3 units.
5. Stitch the blocks together in the order.



6. Measure the width of the runner center (approximately 14-1/2"). Cut two runner border rectangles to that length. Stitch to each end.
7. Stitch the remaining three border 2-1/2" lengths end to end. Measure the length of your runner and cut two pieces that length. Stitch to both long sides of the runner.



8. Cut your backing in half on the fold. Stitch the two short ends together.
9. Layer, quilt and bind.
