Sunny Days Ahead

46" x 46" Wall Hanging



MATERIALS:

[1] AMNSH panel

1/3 yard Blue Toss, for inner border **[A]**

1/2 yard Yellow Solid, for star **[B]**

3/4 yard Flowers, for middle border **[C]**

1 yard, Minnesota Words, Green, for outer border and binding **[D]**

[8] AMNSH Collectible Quilt Shop Blocks

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. FOR THIS PATTERN, WE WILL CUT STRIPS BY THE WOF (WIDTH OF FABRIC)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From AMNSH Panel:

Trim center to 21-1/2" square

From Blue Toss Fabric:

Cut [4] - 4-1/2" × 21-1/2" **[A]**

From Yellow Solid Fabric: **[B]**

Cut [4] - 4-1/2" squares

Cut [32] - 2-1/2" squares

From Flowers Fabric: **[C]**

Cut [4] - 4-1/2" × 21-1/2 rectangles

Cut [8] - 4-1/2" squares

From Minnesota Words, Green Fabric: **[D]**

Cut [4] - 4-1/2" × WOF

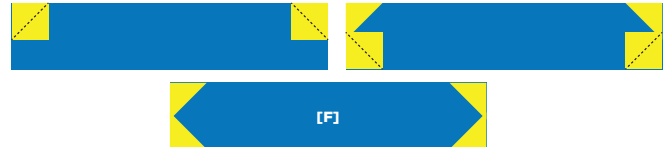
Cut [5] - 2-1/2" × WOF

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Place a **[B]** 2-1/2" square onto one corner of a **[C]** 4-1/2" square. Sew from corner to corner.
2. Cut off outside small triangle, leaving 1/4" seam. Press **[B]** out.
3. Repeat with a second **[B]** 2-1/2" square.
4. Make [8] units. **[E]**



5. Place a **[B]** 2-1/2" square onto one corner of a (A) 4" × 21-1/2" rectangle. Sew from corner to corner.
6. Cut off outside small triangle, leaving 1/4" seam. Press **[B]** out.
7. Repeat with a **[B]** 2-1/2" square on all [4] corners of the **[B]** rectangles.
8. Make [4] units. **[F]**



ROW ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew an **[F]** unit to right and left side of the AMNSH panel.
2. Sew Flowers 4-1/2" × 21-1/2 rectangle **[C]** to the right and left side of the center unit.



3. Sew a yellow 4-1/2" square **[C]** unit to right and left side of an **[F]** unit.
4. Then sew an **[E]** unit on the right and left of that unit, as shown. Make note of the direction of the **[E]** units.
5. Make [2] of these rows.



6. Sew yellow solid 2-1/2" square to the right and left of a Flowers 4-1/2" × 21-1/2 rectangle **[C]**.
7. Then, sew an AMNSH Collectible Quilt Block to the right and left of that unit, as shown. Make [2] rows, making note of the direction of the **[E]** units and the quilt block.



8. Sew these rows together as shown below.



BORDER:

1. Measure center unit, right to left. Trim [2] Minnesota Words, Green 4-1/2" × WOF strips to match measurement.
- 2.. Sew an AMNSH Collectible Quilt Block to the right and left of that those strips.
3. Make 2 strips.



3. Measure center unit, top to bottom. Trim 2 Minnesota Words, Green 4-1/2" × WOF strips to match.
4. Sew these [2] Minnesota Words, Green strips to the right left of the center unit.
5. Sew the outer border with the AMNSH Collectible quilt blocks to the top and bottom of the center unit.



FINISHING:

1. Back, quilt and bind as desired.
